

AI Risks/Threats

- In March 2023, Elon Musk and other experts urged a halt to Al training in an open letter for implementing safety protocols and robust Al governance systems.
- In May 2023, Godfather of AI, Prof. Geoffrey Hinton also expressed concerns on risks of human extinction-level threats in Cambridge. In May 2024, he reiterated this threat in an interviewed with BBC
- Governments are now developing AI regulatory requirements, hoping to contain this risk. Apart from the EU AI Act and US Executive Order on Safe, Secure and Trustworthy AI, U.K. also signed its first international treaty addressing AI risks in Sep 2024. China, Hong Kong and Singapore have all issued regulations or governance framework for Al.
- Corporations, like Microsoft and Google, also have their own Al governance framework nowadays. We need to understand best practices to build our own.


